ATTENDANCE Mayor Dennis Shoaf and Councilmembers Tom Lindsey, Nellie McCain, Charles Jackson, and Mike Ragland were present. Michael Phillips was absent.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Shoaf called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION John Page, Cave Spring Methodist Church, led the invocation.

PLEDGE TO AMERICAN FLAG Councilmember Lindsey led the pledge to the American Flag.

CITIZEN COMMENTS There were no comments.
