- CALL TO ORDER Mayor Ware called the meeting to order.
- ALTON HOLMAN Winifred Morrow, John Johnston, and Nancy Boyd were present. A
HERITAGE ARTS, INC. presentation was given including the history, programs, and future plans for the private non-profit business. Each year they have several residential workshops, a two-week summer theatre arts camp, and various other requested activities. The organization's goal is to acquire its own building with a staff of 35 and an executive director with all being accountable to the fifteen-member Board of Trustees. Support of Council was requested.

- BORING EQUIPMENT Mayor stated that air compressor and missile for boring were included in 2006-

- ROOF AT OLD Mayor stated another portion of old City Hall roof is leaking. Drains need to be
