

CAVE SPRING CITY COUNCIL
CALLED MEETING/WORKSESSION
JUNE 13, 2017
4:30 P.M.

ATTENDANCE	Mayor Dennis Shoaf and Councilmembers Tom Lindsey, Nellie McCain, Charles Jackson, and Mike Ragland were present.
CALL TO ORDER	The Mayor called the meeting to order.
ADJUSTMENTS	Bobby McCord and Johnny Powell were present to speak about their leak at Mud Creek. They are asking for help on a very high water bill due to increased pressure. Other leak requests were discussed. Adjustments will be a regular meeting agenda item.
ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE	Nancy Fricks, member of the Cave Spring Activities Committee, reported that the fire-works for July 4 th will be held July 1 st . She asked the council for a \$1,000 donation plus \$125 (1/2 price of outside lavatory). The council asked if the D.D.A. could pay for the extra \$125. Ms. Fricks also stated the Shriners will hold a car show in front of city hall and vendors, non-profit and local businesses, would be set up beside KC's Food Store. The parade will be held July 4 th .
DAY CARE DIFFERENT.LY	This agenda item was tabled until a later date. Councilmember Ragland stated he was not ready to act on this at this time.
2017-2018 BUDGET	The draft of the 2017-2018 budget was reviewed.
CDBG SEWER PROJECT	The CDBG for the sewer project was discussed. This will be a regular meeting agenda item.
REQUISITIONS	Requisitions for the Water and Sewer Department were discussed.
PERSONNEL POLICIES	Councilmember Lindsey reported that some of the personnel policies need to be revised. The Mayor reported a committee will be appointed for this.
LIAISON FOR D.D.A.	The council liaison for the D.D.A. needs to be appointed.
2017 SPLOST	The Mayor reported the approximate cost for the sewer project will be 2.72 million dollars. Thirty eight projects have been submitted to the SPLOST committee. Cave Spring's SPLOST presentation will be June 22 at 5:30.
ADJOURN	The Mayor adjourned the work session.
