

CAVE SPRING CITY COUNCIL
CALLED MEETING/WORK SESSION
DECEMBER 4, 2007
9:00 A.M.

PRESENT Mayor Rob Ware, Councilmembers Donnie McCain, Nellie McCain, Ken Landers, Kenneth Kelley, and Tony McIntosh attended the meeting.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Ware called the meeting to order.

ALLIED WASTE David Hamilton with Allied Waste Corporation made presentation to Council concerning waste pickup in the City. After January 1st he will meet with Council to give cost proposal.

G.S.D.-LEE SHIVER & KIMBERLY MCGUINESS Lee Shiver, Principal of Georgia School for the Deaf, and Kimberly McGuiness, Chairman of School Council, presented City Council with G.S.D. update. City has been very supportive, and school would like to keep open communication.

SPLOST ORDINANCE- COMMUNITY CENTER MOTION: Donnie McCain made motion to sign amended resolution. Kelley seconded. All voted yes. Plans are currently being completed by architect. Bids will go out early in 2008.

ELECTION ORDINANCE Attorney reported the City's Charter does not conform with Georgia state law. State law requires residency of one month to qualify to vote. City's Charter requires ninety days. Attorney recommended changing Charter to conform with state law. MOTION: Nellie McCain made motion to put on first reading revision to election ordinance. Kelley seconded. All voted yes.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN Council will discuss this at next work session.

GREAT PLAN RESOLUTION Mayor Ware stated that City of Rome has requested that Cave Spring pass a resolution opposing "Great Plan" proposed for State of Georgia. MOTION: Tony McIntosh made motion to empower Mayor to sign resolution opposing "Great Plan". Nellie McCain seconded. All voted yes.

PERSONNEL MOTION: Donnie McCain made motion to go into executive session to discuss personnel. Nellie McCain seconded. All voted yes. MOTION: Kenneth Kelley made motion to come out of executive session. Nellie McCain seconded. All voted yes.

HEALTH INSURANCE MOTION: Ken Landers made motion to change health insurance carrier from GMA to Shaw-Hankins. Donnie McCain seconded. All voted yes.

MOTION TO ADD TO AGENDA- FIRE HALL Mayor Ware reported on status of the new fire station. There has been appraisal on land on Highway 411 North. We need to get cost of land preparation and building. Also, City is looking at cost of constructing fire station on Fincher Street.
